


Dawcartex Agreement

Dear Ted:

Yesterday, I heard that Brynelsen had a call from Toronto office of Noranda asking if he would authorize them to pay the transportation of one Wilfred Dawson from Toronto to Vancouver. Jack Galeitzki gave me the information. He said he understood Dawson was in Noranda's Toronto office this week trying to raise money there to get out to Vancouver. Didn't hear what Bern Brynelsen agreed to do.

Yesterday, I also saw the agreement concerning the nickel staking deal which is filed at Lyle Westley's office in Vancouver. Since I do not know whether you have seen this agreement here are the details.

The agreement is between Dawson and Galeitzki and Dawson, as equal partners, described as prospectors and Noranda.

It was signed Nov 29th, 1956

It refers to a proposal to stake two prospects in the Yukon in the vicinity of some lake, not identified, where the prospectors state nickel mineralization similar to samples shown to Noranda can be found.

The total payment for each property, if and when staked, is the same: \$ 100,000.00 plus 150,000 shares; payments to commence July 31st, 57 & at intervals of six months to July 31st, 1960. Stock to be turned over on or before Oct 31st, 1960.

The payments are to be divided equally between Dawson and Galeitzki, both as to cash and stock.

The prospectors agree to conduct Noranda to the site of the showings on or after May 15th, 1957 and the company agrees the prospectors will not be required to remain at the disposal of Noranda for this job after July 15th, 1957.

Referring to your letter Mar 22nd, it appears that Dawson's interest in this deal consists of (for each showing of two) \$ 50,000.00 plus 75,000 shares in a three million share company. Have not been able to uncover any information here that Dawson has sold any part of his interest. Galeitzki states he has not disposed of his interest, Bob Seraphim, field geologist for Moneta Porcupine, says the last he saw of Dawson was Feb 1st/57 when he was in Moneta's Vancouver office. Galeitzki hasn't seen Dawson here since early February. It is therefore fairly certain that Dawson hasn't been out here since he signed the Pemberton agreement in Toronto,


Dear Ivor:

Received copy of your April 5th letter to Jacka re the gravity meter survey, for which thanks. It appears that the last five lines in SS (h) Section 53 of the Yukon Quartz Mining act would apply as you noted in your letter.

Marcel Dube wired yesterday that he is available to work this summer. Today a letter arrived from him asking a series of questions concerning who would be his boss, would his boss prospector be more experienced than himself etc. I sent you a copy of the original letter outlining the job that I sent to Dube. Will you tell him that I do not know definitely with whom he will be working; that whoever it is he the boss prospector on his team will be more experienced than he (Dube) that the effective dates of employment will be as outlined in the original letter. Please sign Dube up and when that is done let me know.

Re Wilfred Dawson; Found out yesterday that he was in Noranda's office in Toronto early this week requesting transportation to the west coast. Don't know whether he got the fare. In this Yukon nickel deal, Dawson has an equal partner, Jack Gileitzki, who is here in Vancouver. Gileitzki does not know the location of the find but describes it as two separate finds in the vicinity of a lake in the Yukon. Since there is a possibility that either Dawson or Gileitzki may act as guide to the nickel showing for the Noranda stakers, provided the deal is completed, it would be wise to watch for either of them if they show up in Whitehorse. I suspect the so-called find is in the vicinity of the Pelly River; there is also a possibility that there are one or more tunnels or pits on the property. It is certain that Dawson knew of this showing at least three years ago. It is also possible that the nickel showing, unknown to the stakers at that time, was covered by claims in some general staking rush that occurred,

Dear Rod,

Dawson signed agreement on Dawcartex claims to-day and a copy is enclosed. You will note that the escrow agent is Bank of Montreal, Whitehorse. He will have to execute transfers to P.A. and deposit them with the Bank in Whitehorse against the original of his agreement which he has.

Since our company is not registered in B.C. we cannot record the agreement against the claims, so I suggest that before we make the payment we have Ivor Mast get in touch with Dawson on his arrival there and arrange to have Dawson escrow the titles and agreement. You can advise him of this by letter if we take up the claims.

We will also have to make a supplemental agreement by letter on the additional 10 claims to be staked, putting them into the group if as and when they are staked.

In addition to the above claims Dawson advises that there are two separate groups in the area, one of 16 and one of 24, that should be staked if we take up the original group. These are located within 5 miles and 17 miles respectively of the Dawcartex and have similar type of showings. If we are to take the main group Dawson will be available to stake these for us on a basis of \$50.00 per claim and a 10% vendor's interest. He will look after his own expenses of the staking. You can decide whether this is necessary after your preliminary examination and arrange to have Dawson do so while he is out there.

If this Dawcartex deal is taken up no doubt we will have to have a man on the ground looking after these this summer. Perhaps we will need Vaal there to look after the Chu-Chua and the Dawcartex.

Dawson says Williams has the assay slip on the Dawcartex group and he will show it to you on arrival.


