## Exploration History

The Big Bar Claims were staked after discovery of anomalous values in gold during a June 1979 reconnaissance program.

Follow-up mapping and geochemical sampling has revealed anomalous geochemical values in the area of a weathered, brecciated rhyolite. Preliminary sampling results indicate that silica veined zones are anomalous in silver  $(2.6-4.8~\mathrm{ppm})$ , lead (up to 163 ppm), gold  $(10-360~\mathrm{ppb})$  and arsenic  $(30-800~\mathrm{ppm})$ .

The property held by Kerr Addison Mines Limited consists of two claims which comprise a total of 21 units.
