For a belt showing such potential

very little effective work has  
been done <sup>(except on Inco's grounds)</sup> the bulk of the ~~assessment~~  
reports located where concerned with  
assessing the Hg potential and  
Au rarely assayed for.

Getco had the DM claims and  
established a grid and took some  
430 odd soil samples. 2 anomalous  
60 ppb Au values were obtained and an  
isolated As value. Extensive hematite fracture  
veining and large mercury haloes  $\geq 10,000$  ppb  
were reported. Dave Grumble did this  
work in 1961. Apparently <sup>in</sup> subsequent  
drilling very high Hg values were obtained

SS1258  
in the bottom of the hole.
