SUBJECT: Recommendations for Future Work on Last Chance Claims

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- 1) Deadman and Criss Ck should be sampled when water levels come down (2-3 weeks). Samples should be taken from the upstream end of the bar and as far out in the stream as possible. (Use a long handled shovel.)
- 2) Continue dry sampling taking a representative cut through deltas. Go 1 to 1½ ft. down using a pick. If material is damp or wet collect 2 13" X 20" bags of 6 mesh material and send to the lab.
- 3) Using air photos roads should be driven and sampled. Rocks along the main Criss Ck road especially clay altered material on the Cayuse claim should be assayed.
- 4) Investigate red cliffs in the southeast corner of the LC5 claim. Follow-up occurrence of opaline silica found at LC 10 panning site.
