

Blaze Claims 92B12W 5/Sept 84

Robert Beaupre phoned to say they are planning a private placement but would entertain a J/V with a major. They have ground sluiced part of the Area, ~~since~~ bulk sampled a 3 foot wide cut at the 36 Vein (a 2 inch Quartz Vein) which returned .4 to .5 OZ/T Au, and located a 50 ft wide sericite schist that runs .1 to .3 Au, + run a Glen White airborne survey. The logging company apparently plans to log the gulley/valley that is immediately north of the "36" Vein this Fall and/or winter which would give Beaupre better drill access to drill from lower collar elevations to intersect the surface mineralization at depth.

I will contact him after exams at the Veronex + Abo properties + go to Victoria to review the "new" data and re-examine the property.

Thank you very much for showing us your property and allowing us to review the data.

To confirm today's telephone conversation: Kerr Addison Mines Limited do not wish to enter into an option arrangement for Beau Pre Explorations Ltd. Valentine Mtn. Project at this time. We are not prepared to make the cash down payments of \$30,000 to \$45,000 suggested by your Board at our meeting on November 2, 1984, to obtain an option on the claims, especially for a period that ends in May before the weather improves enough to allow us to carry out a mapping programme.

If the property is still available in May 1985 we would consider optioning the claims and conducting a detailed structural mapping programme of the anticline to define possible saddle reef drill targets.

As you requested please find enclosed copies of Kerr Addison's plan and cross-sections which we prepared from your surveyors plan and Grove's drill logs.

Also enclosed are your copies of Grove's 1984 report, White's 1984 Geophysical report, Wingart's B.Sc. thesis and the surveyors plan.
