The Sicker felsic meta-volcanic rocks that host the Twin J deposit, located 55Km NW of Victoria, extend for ±24Km to the ESE of Twin J as far as Saltspring Island. The majority of this favourable area is open for staking.

The favourable WNW extension of this belt is currently held by ESSO and Union Miniere but this ground will likely be forfeited in 1983.

It is recommended that 13 claim blocks (260 units) immediately be staked to cover the favourable ESE extension of the Twin J belt. Ground to the WNW may be staked as it becomes available.

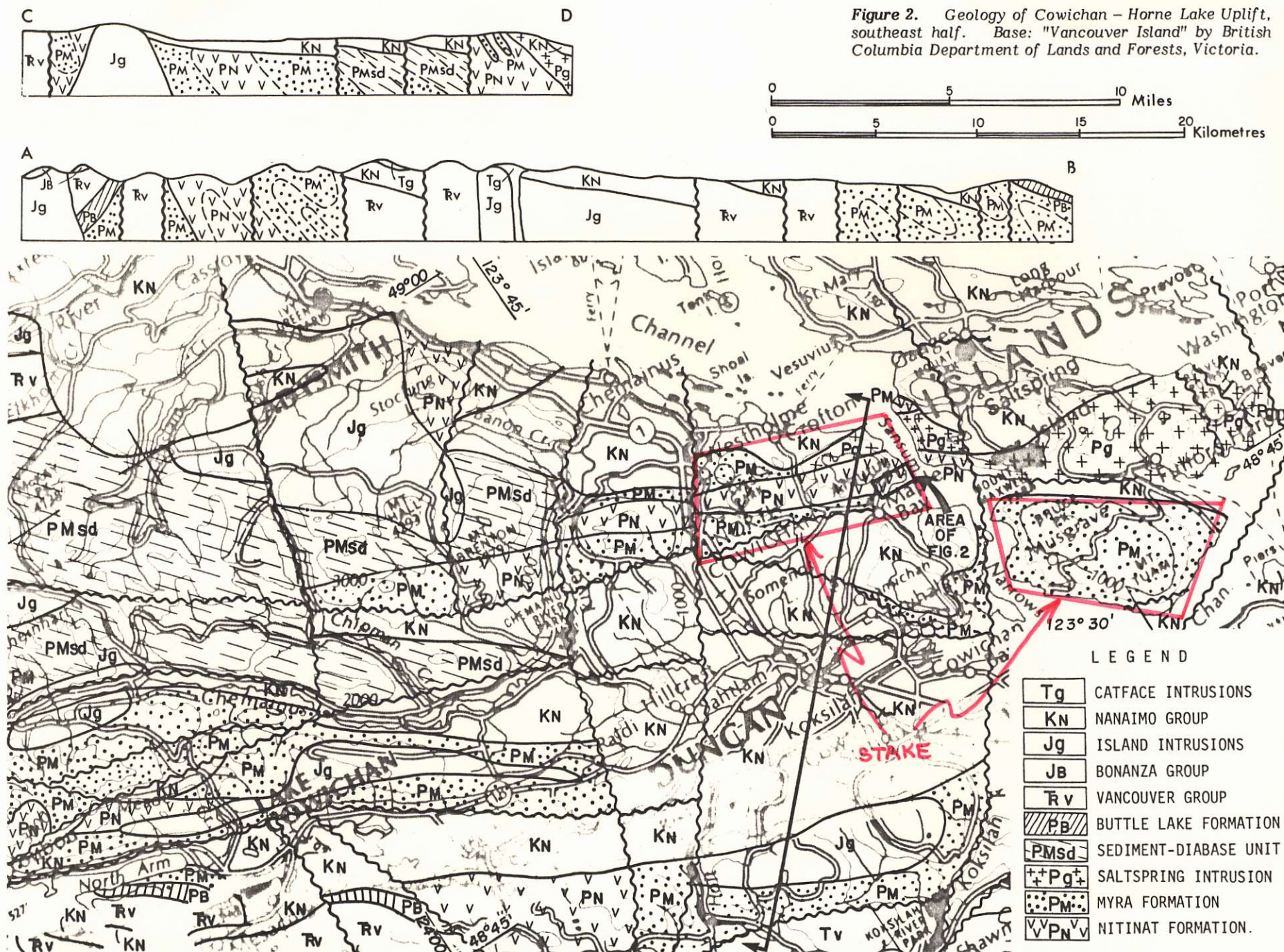
It may seem premature to be staking this ground prior to completing the detailed (review of assessment files) compilation work first. I believe, however, that C.F.C. should grab the ground while it is still available.

In order to keep this ground in good standing for the 1984 field season, \$26,000 of assessment work will have to be filed during 1983. This will likely be "covered" adequately by our proposed 1983 reconnaissance program.
