Three areas on Mt. Sicker will be surveyed by IP in February. These areas are: 1) Lines 5E - 1200W from 500S to 1500S (17 km). This will attempt to trace the Lenora-Tyee horizon west to the edge of the Peppa property. 2) Lines 0E to 2000E from 150N to 800N (13 km). This will cover the Gabriel Chert horizon which has never been surveyed. 3) Lines 4300E to 5000E both north and south of the base line (7 km).

Both MPH Consulting (who did the IP in Dec/85 on the Killer Gossan) and Al Scott (who did the Mt. Armour IP survey) submitted bids on the job.



The survey will be run in the pole-dipole configuration with dipole spacing of 25m. and reading nl-5. Al thinks he can get 2 km/day productivity. The survey is expected to last approximately 20 days and will cost approximately \$29,000.
