Preliminary indicators from available data are that the mineralization on this property is classic, deformed massive sulphides with stringers in mafic to intermediate flows. The area, immediately east of Harrison Lake, is readily accessible and, apart from the Orbex claims, almost completely open. It is definitely the type of situation which warrants our further consideration.

Consequently I would recommend that we approach Orbex to express our interest and obtain permission to view their drill core which is stored at a lumber camp close to the property. In addition we should try to view all data which they have.

In the meantime a compilation is underway for the area as well as for the Seneca area to the west of Harrison Lake.
