Herewith Fred Chow's report together with accompanying maps.

Fred has described the work done in considerable detail but his report now requires modification as a result of the geochemical consultation work done by John Hajek. By the same token his budgeting for 1974 work will have to be modified because of the amount of money available to do this work and because drilling targets as such will also be selected after some additional field work has been done. This field work, apart from geological observation, will consist largely of narrowing down the two areas of geochemical promise.

It would now appear that the best target areas are on Greenland Creek and Nine Creek and it looks as though we can abandon the area trenched last year at least for the time being.

There appears to be a distinct zonal pattern to the geochemistry with tungsten and molybdenum occurring closest to the intrusion followed in succession northward by a high zinc area containing some copper and then the very pronounced lead area which contains little else.

In my view the tungsten-molybdenum area which appears to coincide with the intersection of two fault zones at the monzonite contact now constitutes the best area for ore search. I do not discount the copper-zinc anomalous area west of the dome on the south side of Greenland Creek but in the main, copper-zinc deposition thus far in that particular area has not been important. A pod of this type of mineralization had been previously located on the Mc group and consisted of copper-zinc mineralization in a fault zone cutting quartzites.

Our work this coming summer should be conclusive in the evaluation of the Dewar Creek claim block.
