RE: MOOSESKIN JOHNNY LAKE AND TELKWA PASS PROPERTIES

I have had a chance to check the files here in Victoria and there is quite a bit of information on at least part of the properties as follows:

MooseSkin Johnny Lake

The area including both the Skin 1-4 and Moo 1-4 claims is covered by a detailed 1"=500' geological map done by Bethex in 1968. There is no record of their drilling in the Government files so you're lucky to have this information. The drilling would have been done within the present boundaries of the Moo claims.

The present claims cover the old War Eagle and Santa Maria prospects on which considerable work was done by Norcan Mines Ltd. (and Bethex) between 1966 and 1968. Maps showing results of geophysical surveys (airborne mag plus surface IP and SP) and soil geochemistry are available (Cu results only). There are also copies of drill sections and trench plans for the Santa Maria zone (present Skin 1-4 claims) with assays (Cu and Ag values only). Reports by Stan Hunter, then consultant to the company are also available - one of these includes 1967 reserve estimates for the Santa Maria which are indicated and inferred 1.07 million tons grading 1.48% copper and 0.97 oz/ton silver in three zones.

There is no indication of any assaying for gold in either the War Eagle or Santa Maria zones other than the one Bethex drill hole with two 10 ft. intervals grading 0.70 and 0.275 oz/ton. Jim Cuttle's report does not indicate any "barnburner" gold numbers but it may be worthwhile to consider some additional sampling.

MEL Claims

I can find nothing in the Government files re this property other than the Lacana 1981 report - confirmatory sampling is warranted.

Recommendations - I think it worthwhile to compile some of the old data on the MooseSkin Johnny claims prior to considering additional fieldwork. Please advise if you want me to do this.
