**Re: Leo D'Or Mining Inc. - Bonanza Lake  
Application for License of Occupation**

Further to our meeting of November 18, I wish to advise that documentation in support of the application should be in hand shortly.

In response to a few of your expressed concerns, I am able to provide the following information. The 1993 program, Pursuant to a Notice of Work filed with Ministry of Energy Mines and Petroleum Resources, got underway May 24. Portable camp trailers were transported to the site May 31.

To date, some 22 marble blocks have been extracted from the principal area of investigation. These blocks measure 5 x 5 x 10 feet and 6 x 6 x 8 feet and weigh 18 to 22 tonnes respectively. One block has been transported by rail to Quebec for sampling purposes.

A "Permission to Cross BC Hydro Transmission Right of Way" was signed by Leo D'Or November 22, 1993 and forwarded for signature to Nelson Storry, P.Eng., BC Hydro in Nanaimo.
