Dear Sirs:

In accordance with your instructions I made an examination of your properties situated on Babine Lake in the Amnecia Mining District.

The purpose of the inspection was to check certain information tendered you as to the conditions and values obtaining on this property and to offer practical suggestions and recommendations for future development.

I have examined carefully the reports of Messrs. (Douglas Fay,) Johnston and Bacon and find that their conclusions are well founded. A check of the values indicates that very high grade ore exists on the property especially on the Silver Island claim where considerable development has been done in years past. Samples from the north shore of the lake and from enclosing rock adjacent to the rich ore on the island indicate that a zone of values exists quite apart from the distinctly high grade leads and it is my opinion that attention should be

ected to the development of this condition especially on the north shore claims.

In checking over the values indicated in the reports mentioned above practically identical results have been obtained. I took four samples of rock other than that disclosed in the high grade veins resulting as follows:

- (1) 105 oz. silver value \$72.45
- (2) 91.47 oz. silver Value 63.11
- (3) 75.89 oz. " " 52.36
- (4) 31.87 " " 21.99

Samples 1 & 2 are from the island. No. 3 & 4 are from the north shore tunnel.

I shall forward you a complete report of my findings in the course of a few days.

For the present suffice it to say that I consider the property well worth development and that no difficulties of consequence are evident that would militate against an economical opening up of the property.
