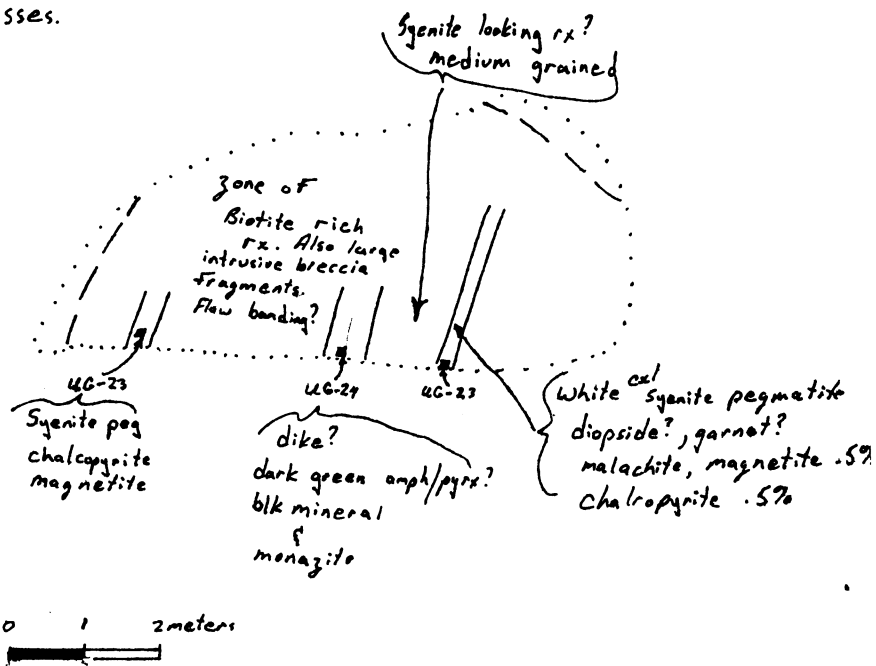

MAP TYPE Free hand

gneisses.



Found within gneisses and augen gneisses.

UG-23: looks like a calsilicate rock but has no carbonate, does have diopside and garnet, fractured Feldspar with 1% chalcopyrite and magnetite. It could be a syenite pegmatite.

UG-24: Breccia pipe? rare earth dike?, very heavy, dk green amphiboles/pyroxenes?, mafic, shiny black metal, honey flat fibrous crystals (monazite). Slightly calcareous. Carbonatite dike?

The zone of biotite has in it a green volcanic looking rock with large angular fragments of a pink intrusive. There also appears to be flow banding around some of the fragments
