

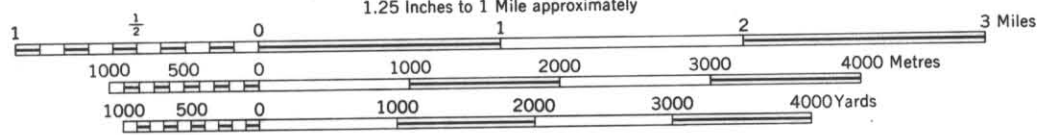

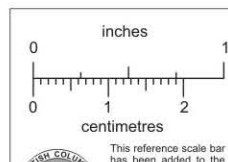
MAGNETIC DECLINATION 27°54' EAST
