carbonaceous

- Partially silicified shale/argillite  
moderately heavy, grey-blue  
some grey sulfides (<1%)  
weathered in light rusty red  
quartz veins  
Some ~~quartz~~ brecciation of  
quartz veins  
Some yellow stain (limonitic)

- may be carbonaceous.

OUTCROP

- Quartz veins and mineralized country rock. (15cm wide vein)
- Moderately fractured
- weathered rusty red.
- fresh surface, med-gray.
- Disseminated Pyrite, also in Blebs (2%)
- limonitic staining (yellow & orange)
- orientation [350/56N]
- 2 or 3 parallel veins (15cm)

Outcrop, Silts Stone,  
Mudstone. Rusty weathering  
Well bedded, dipping  $30^{\circ}$   
Highly Fractured. Some  
Solicification, less than  
1% primary porosity

T24T1-68

Outcrop, Solicified?  
Probably mudstone.  
Grey matrix. Some  
pyrite, - primary.  
Breaks flintlike Brown  
weathering 1m wide.  
May be faulted both  
ends.
