Re: M504 - Surrender of the GOAT, GOAT I and 2 Claim

EARL D. DODSON:

The purpose of this memo is to obtain permission to drop the GOAT, and GOAT I and 2 claims in Northwestern British Columbia. These claims were staked in 1981 and are one of the northernmost claim blocks in the Northern Gold project (M504). These claims were staked to cover a large alteration zone and a float sample that had a value of 4950 ppb Au.


Careful prospecting, geological mapping and soil, rock and silt sampling failed to outline any samples that were anomalous in gold despite having similar characteristics. The claim straddles the Nahlin fault zone which has alpine ultramafic along its length. The southern portion of the claim is underlain by the Jurassic Inklin formation which is comprised of calcareous siltstones and sandstones. This sequence has been intruded by Cretaceous and Early Tertiary quartz-feldspar porphyries. All of these rock types have been sampled extensively but no anomalous gold values were obtained.

The total expenditure to date on these claims is \$20,000. Can. (\$15,000. US). The claims are due to expire on July 20, 1985 and August 21, 1985. Your immediate approval is requested to surrender these claims.
