R.E. DANIEL:

The Zap 1-4 mineral claims located in the Windermere district of the Canadian Rocky Mountains were originally staked to cover zinc showings and geochemistry. The showings are carbonate-hosted zinc deposits.

The last work done, in 1977, indicated the existence of mainly fracture controlled mineralization in Jubilee dolomite.

In view of the limited showings and the nature of the target, no further work was recommended.

The claims are due to expire August 25, 1980 and August 25, 1981. I recommend that they be allowed to lapse.
