## NEWS RELEASE

Mr. Lloyd E. Tattersall reports:

The Company is pleased to announce that it is in possession of Report 18 in Current Research, Part A, Paper 87-1A, Geological Survey of Canada. The report is entitled "A Placer Gold Exploration Target in the Cariboo District, British Columbia." Project 810006 by John J. Clague, Terrain Sciences Division, Vancouver.

This report pinpoints a previously unknown, buried Quaternary Valley in the Cariboo District of Central British Columbia. This Valley is located 3 km south of Cariboo Lake; it is similar in form to the nearly <u>Bullion Valley</u> which has yielded over 120,000 ounces of placer gold. In addition, one of the richest placer streams in the Cariboo, is located only 6 km to the north. These observations suggest that the buried Valley may itself contain placer gold and thus should be considered a priority mineral exploration target.

The Company takes the greatest pleasure in announcing that this <u>Buried Valley</u> is totally located within the boundary of the Company's placer gold property, just east of the Cariboo River, 3 km south of the south end of Cariboo Lake. The Valley is about 1 km long and 150 - 200 m wide and is easily accessible by logging road.

It is the intention of the Company to move onto this property as expeditiously as possible and commence a drilling programme to be recommended by the Company's Geologist, Mr. Uwe Schmidt, B.Sc., FGAC.
