Brad claim group 1-88, Vernon B.C.

Area underlain by volcanics of the Kamloops group (Tertiary), Permian-Permian sedimentary and volcanic rocks and Shuswap, Precambrian and volcanic rocks and meta-sediments. Very complicated geology includes flows, tuffs, pyroclastics and sediments. (Attached copies of magnetic and topo maps). The low-contrast magnetic area in the southern half of the claim block is Jurassic or Cretaceous acid rocks, granodiorite, monzonite et al. Large porphyry copper deposits occur within this group of rocks a short distance southwest of the area. The magnetic maps in our file were very helpful for evaluation. The prospect appears to be interesting enough to warrant further consideration. More detailed research on latest maps will have to be done on this prospect.

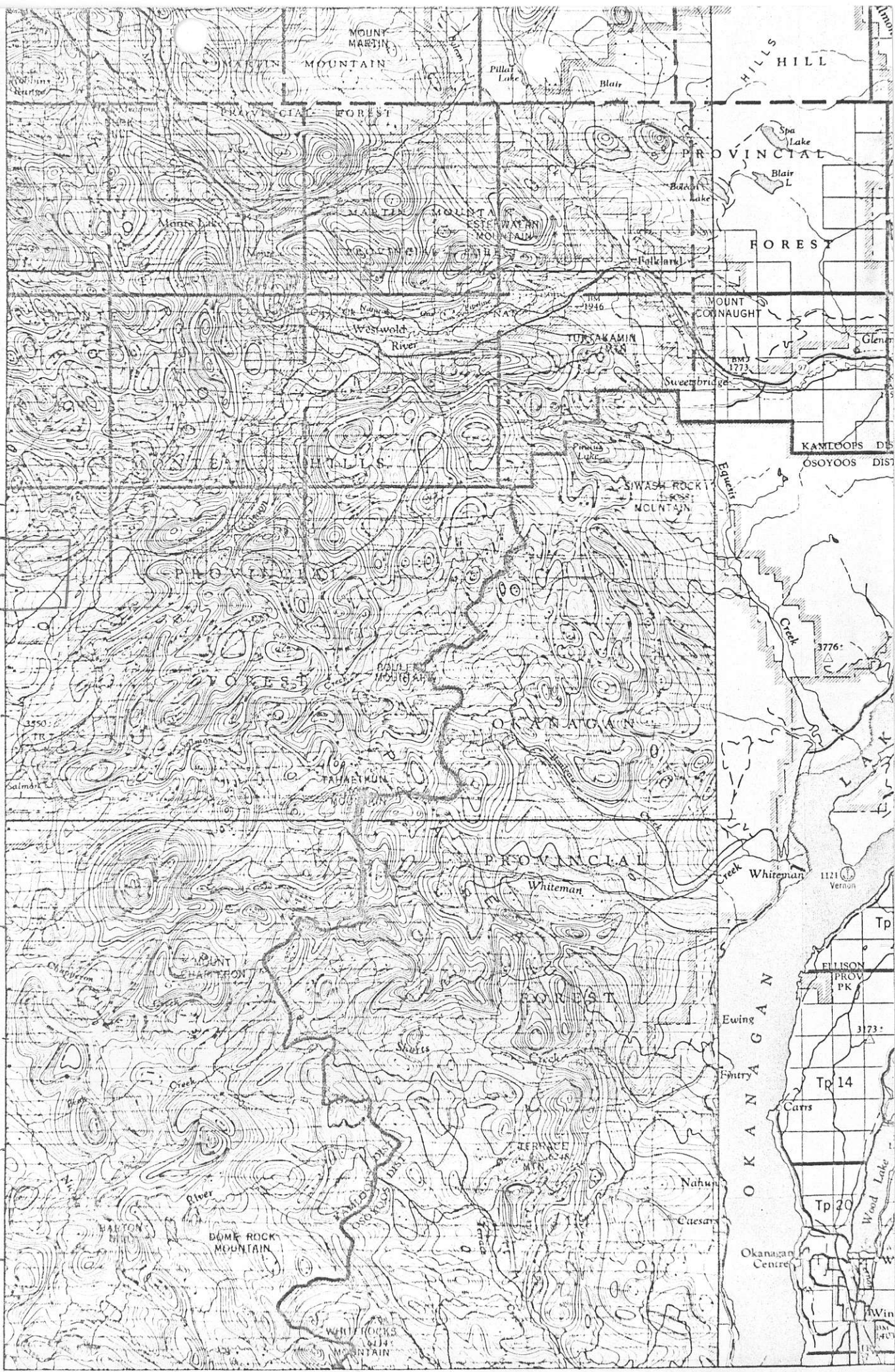

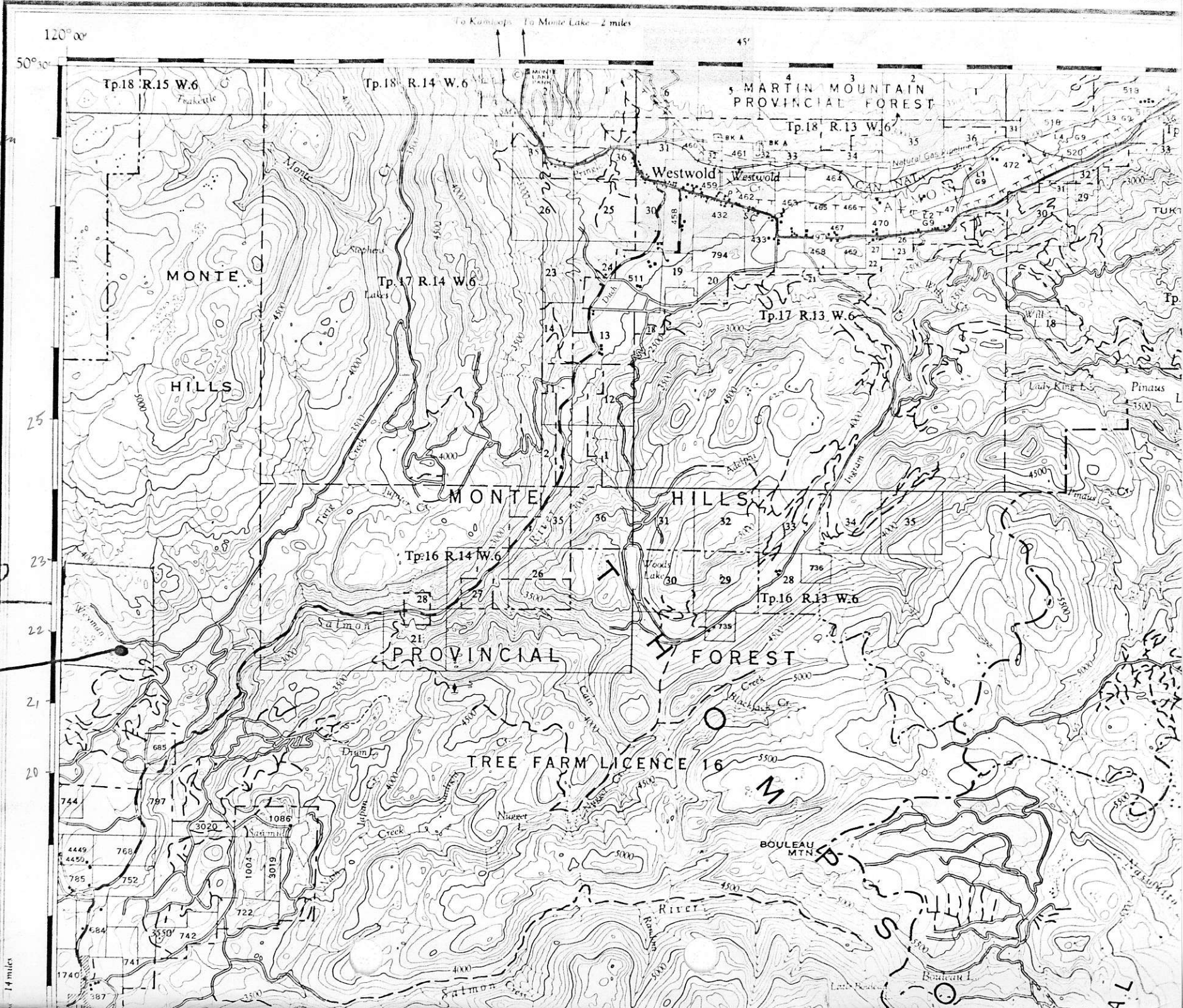

But they are not interested in it; they want to find a mine.

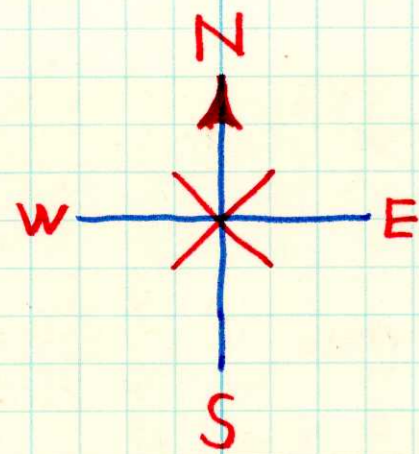

We will send long & lat info on trenches. I'd like to plot those exactly. Tisdale & Colombo are very heavily prospecting and have more prospects and much tie-on land.

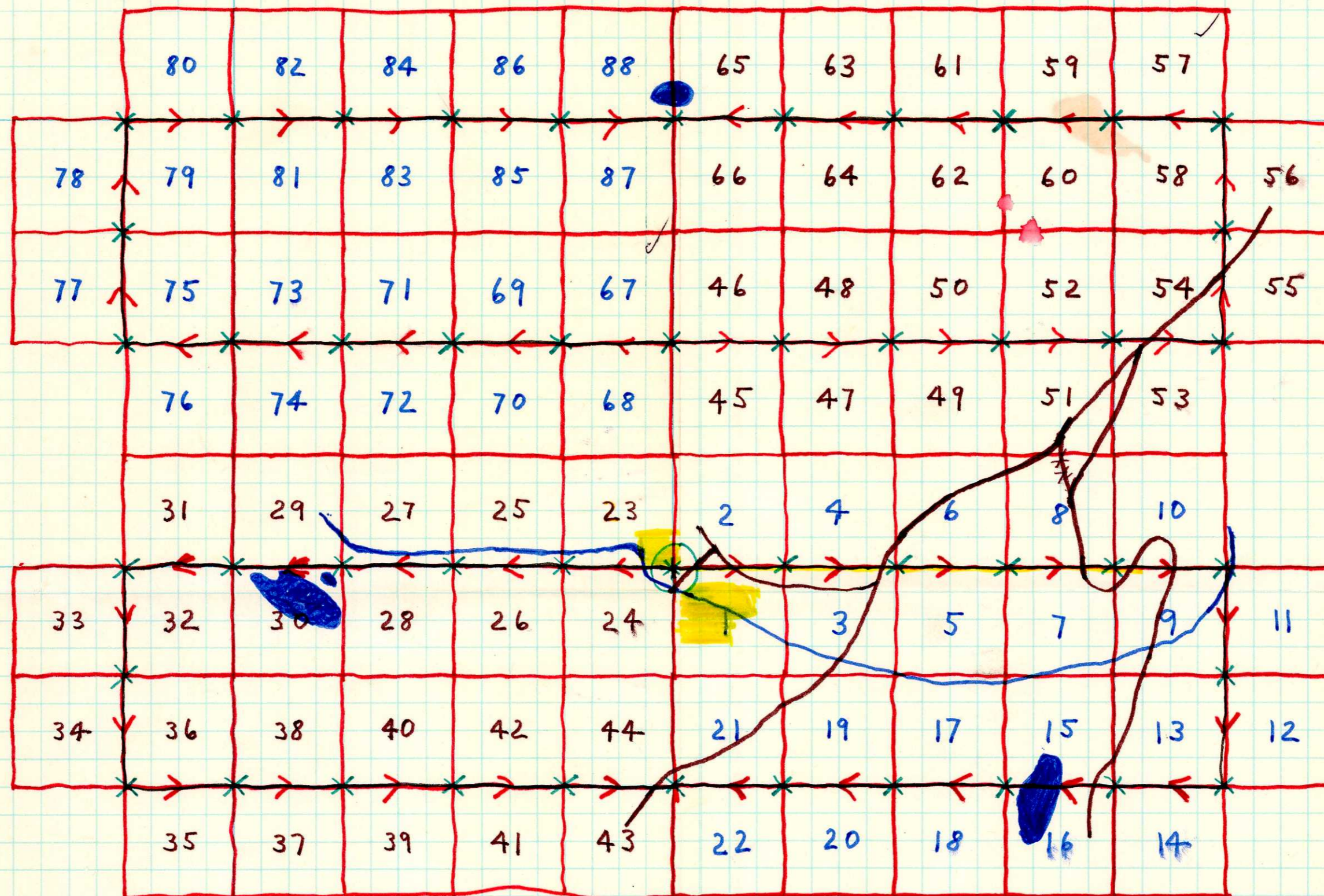

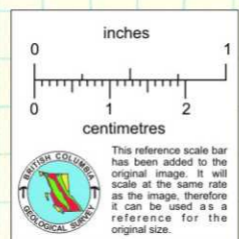


