LOUISE ISLAND

Louise Islandis dissected by a major portion of the Louscoone-Rennell sound fault and numerous strands of the same. The major fault changes orientation abruptly in the center of the island. A large 'post tectonic' pluton bounded by the fault to the north makes up about a quarter of the island.

The Iron Duke showing on the north east part of the island is a magnetite skarn formed within the Kunga Formation the has been intruded by a diorite stock.

Very little recent work has been done on the island and the ground is completely open. The topography is extremely rugged and may limit access to some extent.
