Claims

About 35 units

Geology

Cretaceous sediments, including calcareous siltstones, minor Jurassic/Triassic limestones or limy argillites. Details are uncertain since overburden cover is fairly extensive. At least one major fault, belonging to the Rennel Sound Fault system, appears to pass through the property

Geochemistry

An area at least 3 mi x $\frac{1}{2}$ mi in size is strongly geochemically anomalous in Hg and As, with occasional high Au values. The distribution of values is shown on the accompanying sketch.

Discussion

Although Au highs per se are sparse, the consistently high Hg and As, the presence of major faulting (parallel to the Sandspit fault system) and the excellent road access, make this a desirable property to follow-up on.

Deal

The following terms have been offered (and, except for one detail, accepted):

Down payment Dec. 1979 \$10,000. Next payment Jan. 1981 10,000. Next payment Jan. 1982 15,000. Each year thereafter Jan. 15,000.

All other terms are to be as outlined in our established Queen Charlotte Gold Agreement.
