SUMMARY NOTES  
HOWE #1 CLAIM

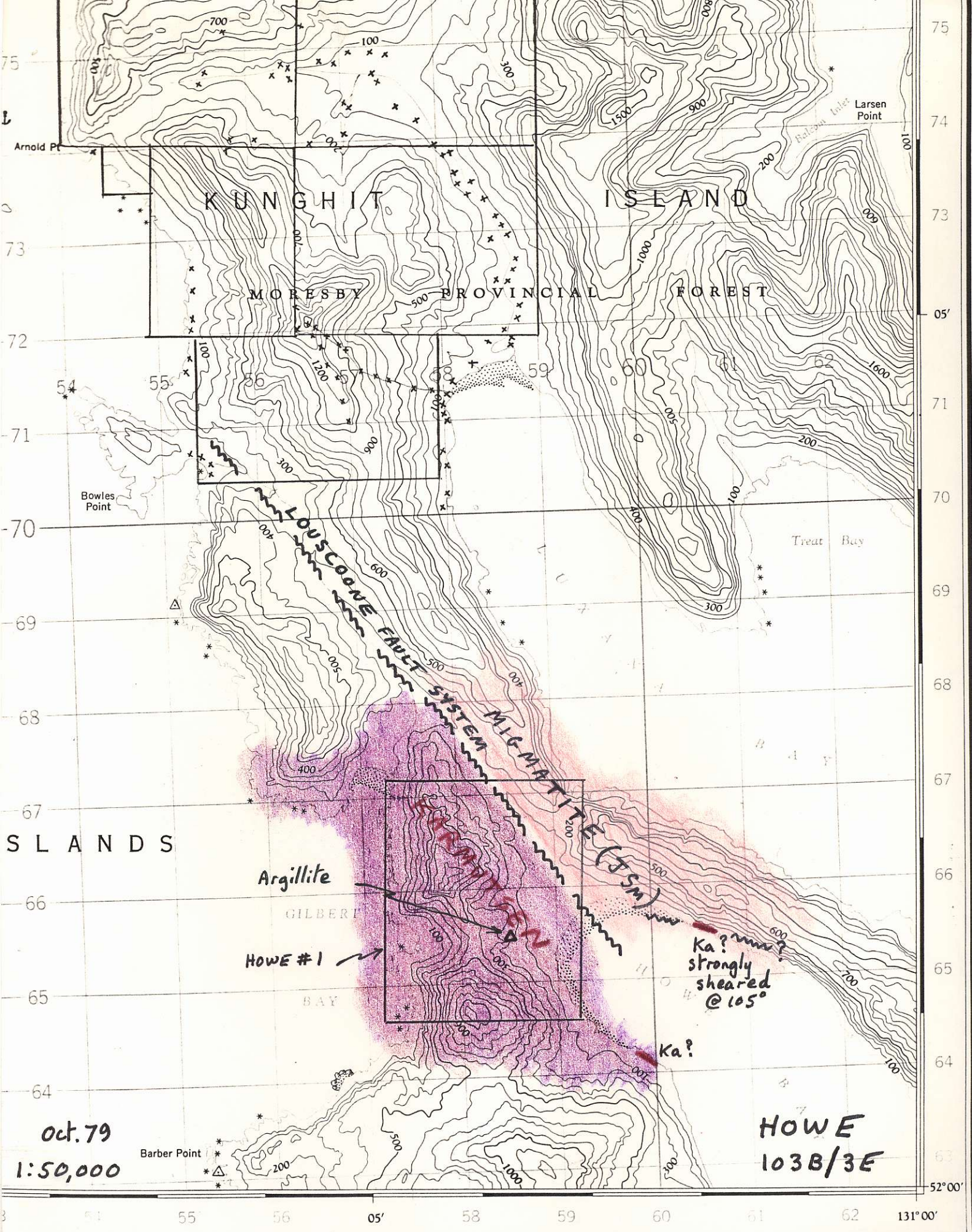
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- Location: Howe Bay, 148 km SSE of Sandspit, Q.C.I.
- Claim: Howe #1, 20 units.
- Geology: A major strand of the Louscoone Fault System crosses the claim, separating Karmutsen volcanics from a migmatitic complex. In detail the geology is probably more complex, but outcrop exposure is not common. Argillaceous float has been seen in the anomalous area. One outcrop examined in the area believed to be migmatite, looked like strongly sheared Karmutsen andesite with the shearing paralleling the local shoreline.
- Geochemistry: About 35 reconnaissance geochemical samples have been collected from the claim and its vicinity. 5 modest Au highs are grouped near the trace of the Louscoone Fault.
- Conclusions: Although the grouping of geochemical highs is interesting, and encouraging results have been forthcoming from the Louscoone Fault vicinity elsewhere, the lack of known alteration, probable lack of host rocks normally considered suitable, and relatively distant location, make this prospect unattractive.

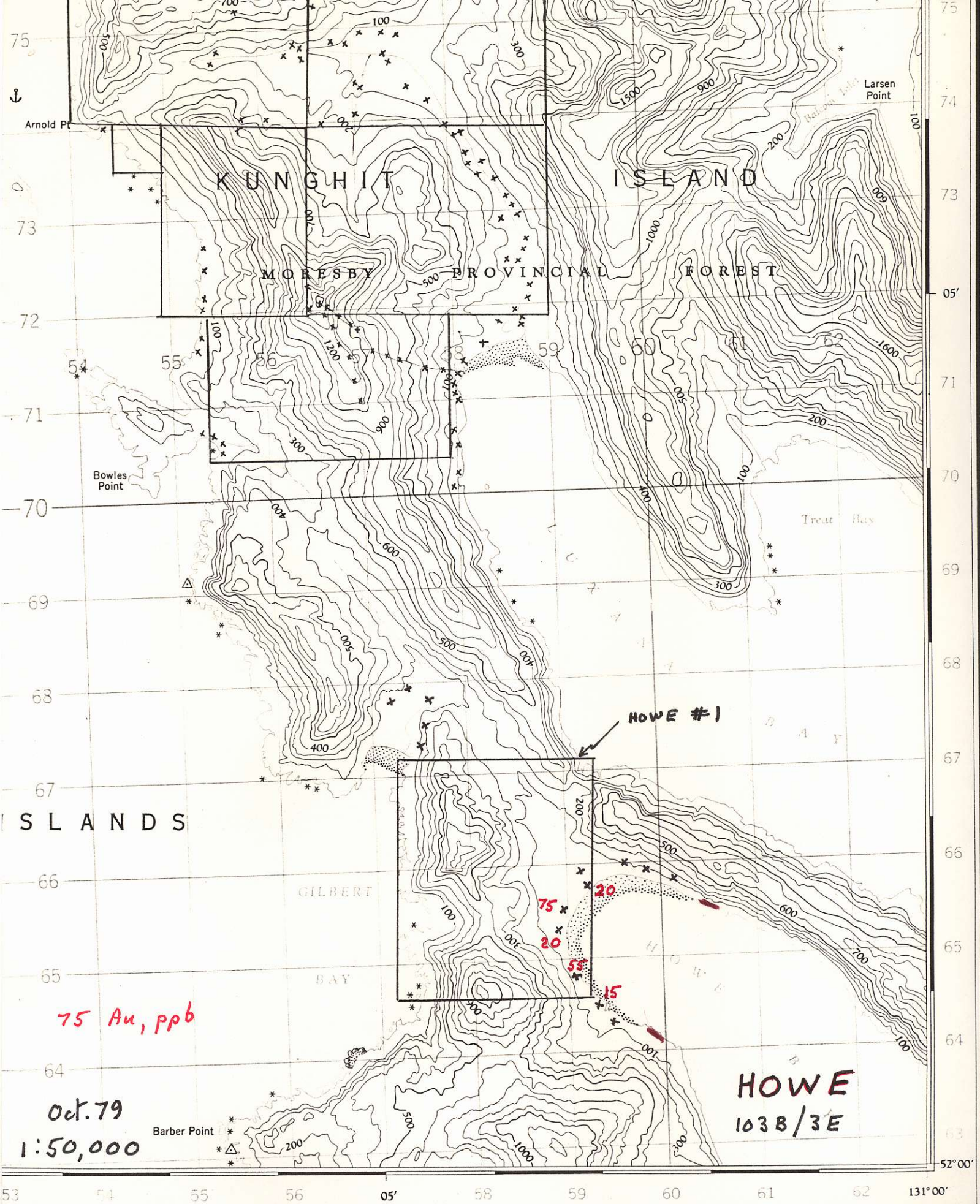
