EARL D. DODSON:

The purpose of this memo is to obtain permission to surrender the GRINGO claim in Northwestern British Columbia. This claim was staked in 1981 to cover an alteration zone along the Nahlin fault during a time when competitors were suspected to be staking in the area.

The work carried out to date consists of prospecting, geological mapping, combined with soil and rock sampling. The claim is entirely underlain by the Nahlin ultramafic suite which occupies the Nahlin fault zone. It has intense quartz-carbonate alteration, but no anomalous gold values have been obtained from any of the rocks on the property. The soil samples are typical – very low (5 ppb Au). The best soil sample (700 ppb Au) was resampled and also a small grid was established around it, but the value could not be reproduced.

The total expenditure to date on this claim is \$10,000 Can. (\$8,000 US). This claim is due to expire August 21, 1985. Your immediate approval is requested to surrender this claim.
