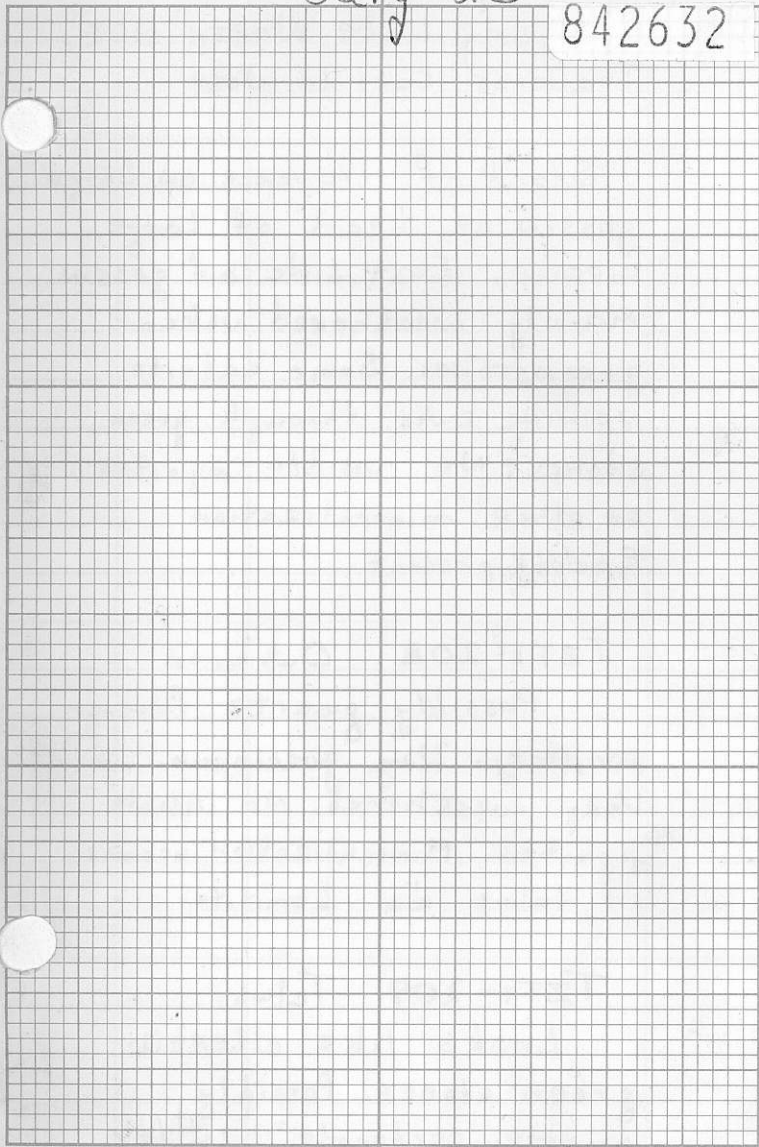

Tunjony Lake, NORTH SIDE  
Traverse East to West

Start of traverse on large gossin at head of large CIRQUE. East side of gossin mainly weathered volcanic greenstones. Some calcite veining cuts through green stones. No visible pyrites or other mineralization  
Epidote present

TZTI-208 Outcrop

Possibly quartz feldspar porphyry. Very gossinuous. Very weathered. No visible pyrites. Mineralization occurs in talus as hematite.

TZTI-209 Talus.

Looks like altered green stones. Possibly quartz carbonate. little

weathering. Fairly solificied  
No visible pyrites. Rusty exterior

TZTI-210

Quartz Carbonate. Found in  
talus. Very solificied. Quartz &  
Calcite present. Gossin area. Exterior  
Rusty. Fuchsite present.

TZTI-211

Quartz vein. Outcrop but just  
extending above surface. Disseminated  
sulphides in places. Strikes  $50^{\circ}$   
Trace malacite.

TZTI-212

Outcrop. Gossin area.  
Beautiful solificied quartz brecha.  
Very rusty exterior. Some sulphides  
in rocks. Quartz solificied and in  
crystals. Very vuggy. Host rock  
bleans

TZT1-213

Quartz carbonate. Rusty  
interior, from position. Cuts  
through greenstone. Silicified  
and quartz veined. No visible  
pyrites
