Tm & Sh UNDIFFERENTIATED MARINE (AQUAGENE) TUFFS
& BLACK SHALE, THINLY INTERBEDDED

- NOTES: 1- UNIT Tm INCLUDES BLACK SILTY TUFF, BLACK TO LIGHT GREY CHERTY TUFF, & LIGHT GREY CHERT, ALL INTERBEDDED WITH UNIT Sh; BANDING VARIES FROM VERY THIN LAMINAE (1/32") TO THICKNESSES OF SEVERAL FEET.
- 2- PYRITE IS PRESENT IN ALL HORIZONS EXCEPT THE LIGHT GREY CHERTS AND CONSTITUTES FROM 1 - 30% OF THE ROCKS. (% PYRITE INCREASES AS ROCK COMPOSITION VARIES FROM CHERT TO SHALE).
- 3- DIPS THROUGHOUT THE DRILL HOLE ARE CONSISTENT AT 50° A DDH AXIS.
