SUBJECT: Property Submission: Robb Lake area, British Columbia

This morning Mr. L.B. Halladay took a telephone call from a Mr. Joe Chiavarini of St. Catharines (Tel: 682-9979). Mr. Chiavarini owns 809 claims lying on to the west of the Texas Gulf Sulphur, Robb Lake group. He wants to retain 200 of these claims to work on himself but he wants to make a deal on the remaining 600-odd claims.

Messrs. Halladay, Watson and Bruce looked at the relevant geological map (G.S.C. Map 22-1963 94-B) and it appears that the offered property is underlain by Ordovician and Silurian sediments which apparently have been thrust over the favourable Devonian formations which occur at the Robb Lake property.

Since this ties in with the Woodcock Nahanni project, it was decided to telephone Jorex to pass along this information and also to get an expert opinion from Dick Woodcock. If the property were of interest, we feel it should be shared with Jorex. Hugh Fraser told us he had heard from the same man yesterday and that he discussed the proposition with Joe Rankin. From previous discussions between Rankin and Woodcock it was evident that in this area all the good ground had already been staked by Texas Gulf and Brinco. Therefore Mr. Fraser is going to telephone Mr. Chiavarini to-day to turn down the offer. We will do likewise.
