geochemistry and geophysics

- Texas Gulf drilled 12 holes in 1967

- NW of breccia showing.

*note that grades in UTG drilling appear to be getting higher toward breccia.

- long, narrow Cu soil geochem anomaly (> 400 ppm Cu) coincident w/ breccia zone.

- I.P. results indicate a chargeability anomaly partially coincident w/ breccia zone & soil anomaly.

- interpretation:

- large, low grade (sub-economic) tonnage of Cu (~ 0.18% Cu and Au = ? maybe .005 w/ zones of higher grade breccia (13m. of 1.06% Cu and 0.26 g/t Au)

- recommendation:

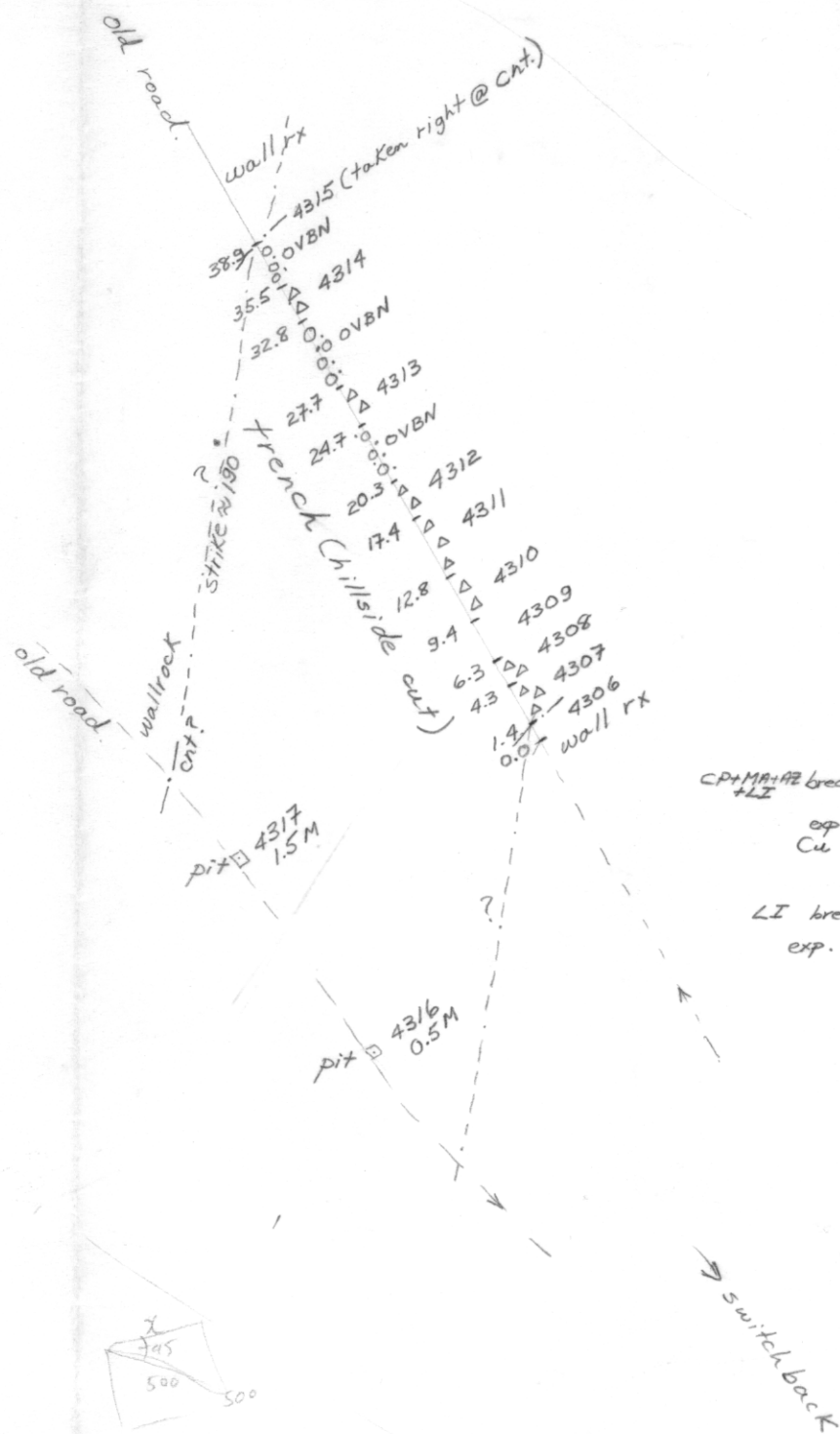
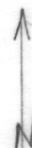
- higher grade zones are too small and of insufficient grade to be value/tonne to be of interest

- large, lower grade zones appear to be of insufficient grade to be of interest.

- possible for possibility exists to SE of breccia zone to locate additional breccias

- no further action recommended.
