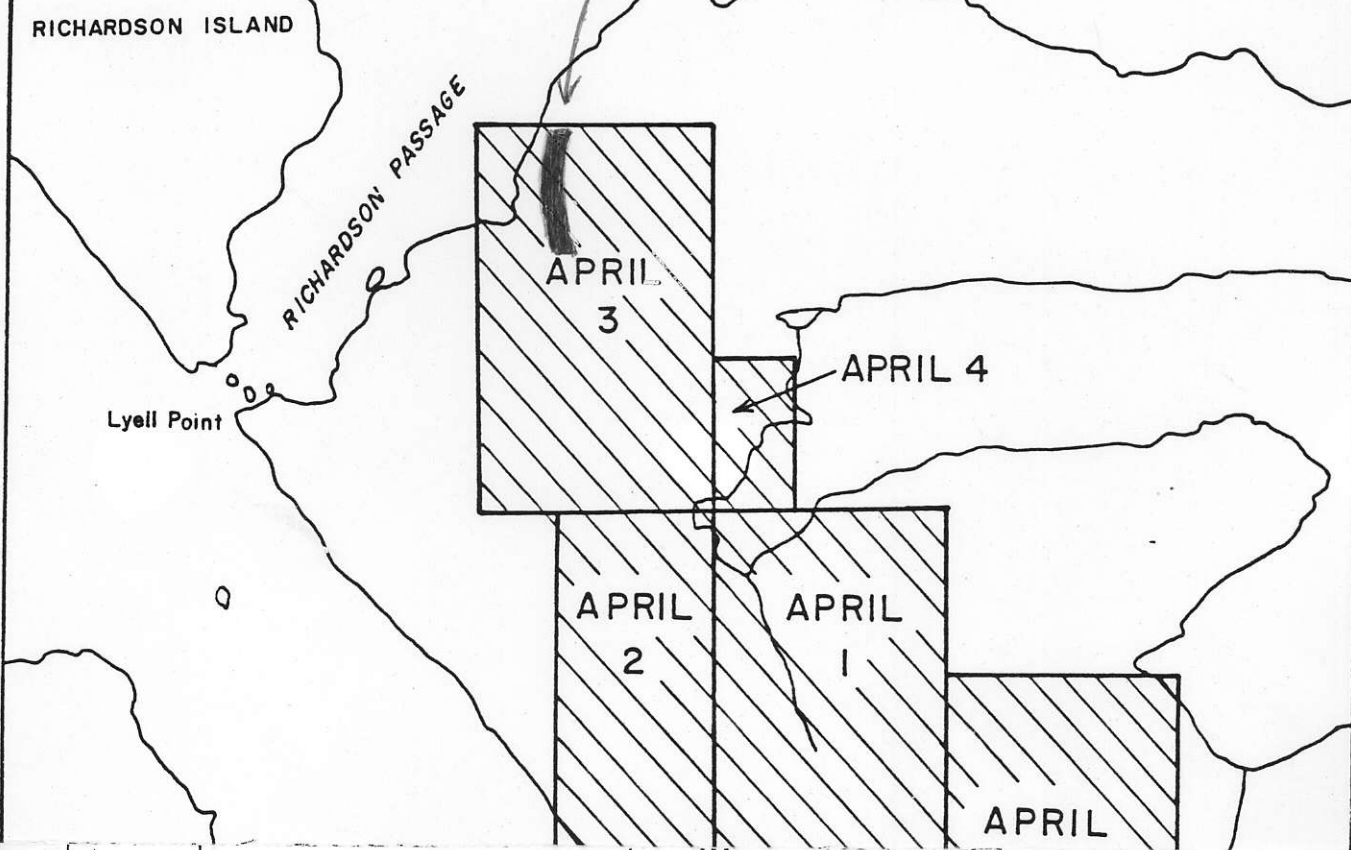

DRILL HOLES, CAMP SITE.



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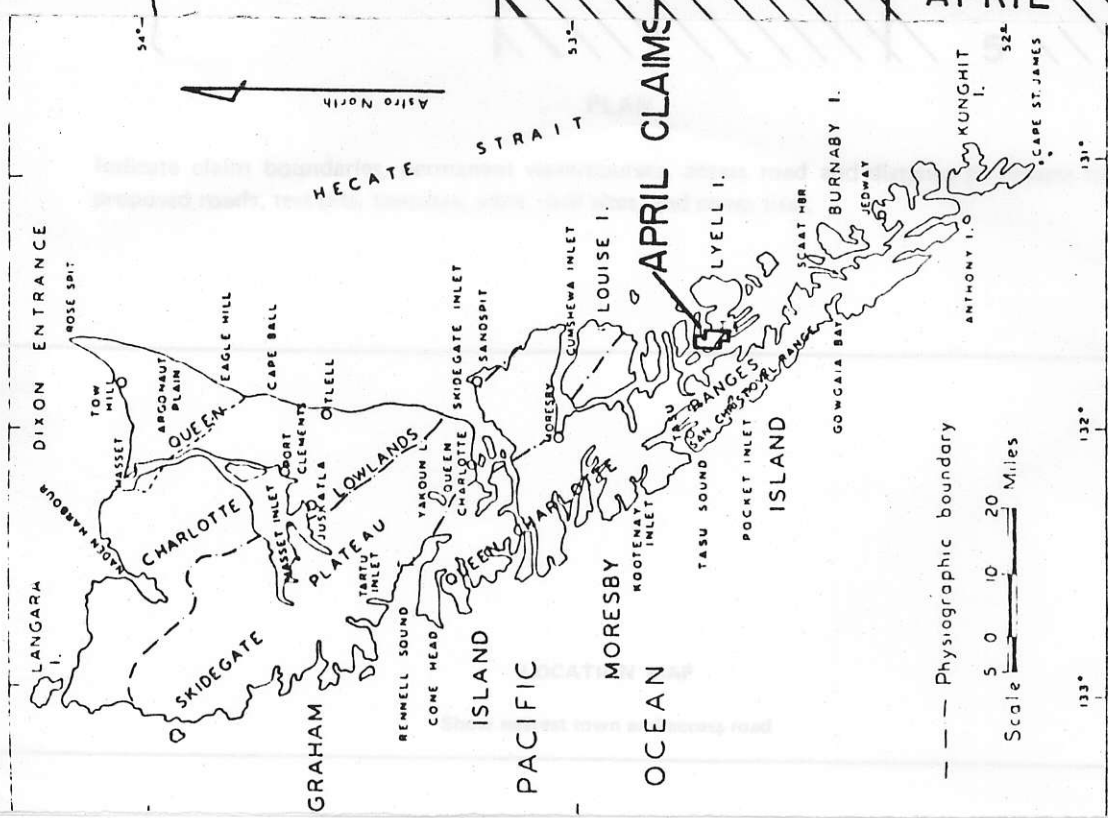


Fig. 1. Index map of the Queen Charlotte Islands.

I hereby agree, in cutting and removing timber on and from the said area, to comply with the following conditions:

(1) To comply with all regulations of the Forest Service in connection with the prevention and suppression of forest fires, and to pay all expenses incurred in carrying out such regulations and all expenses incurred because of fires starting on land covered by this permit.

(2) Dead timber, standing and down, will be used wherever possible.

(3) Stumps will be cut as low as practicable and not higher than _____

(4) Slash resulting from the operation shall be disposed of as follows:

That if I fail to carry out any of the conditions herein, the Minister of Lands, Forests, and Water Resources may cancel this permit without previous notification.

This permit shall expire on the 1 day of SEPTEMBER, 1981
or shall be subject to cancellation on 30 days' notice in writing, and on or before such date of expiry or cancellation, as the case may be, all cutting under this permit will cease.
