> Re: Luc Syndicate - Burn Group - Proposed 1976 Drilling.

Dear Bill:

During our conversations in Vancouver in January, we discussed a possible drilling programme on the subject property. You asked me to lay out what I thought would be an appropriate drilling programme.

I now enclose herewith two sets of plans and sections showing proposed drill holes. You will note that these holes are laid out in the form of two cross-sections with two "scissor" holes on each section. For the purpose of this discussion, these holes are temporarily called L - 1-4, inclusive. You will note that the suggested footage is approximately 3050 feet.

My reasoning in suggesting these holes is as follows:

- Holes L-1 and L-2 are intended to crosssection the area of interest as defined by Lorne Halladay and I in our field examination.
- Holes L-3 and L-4 are intended to crosssection a covered area which appears to be on the up-hill end of a substantial molybdenum geochemical anomaly as defined in the original work and as confirmed in the 1975 field programme. Also, L-3 and L-4 appear to be favourably located with respect to a "zone of abundant mineralized float." as illustrated by Mustard in his 1975 report.

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These holes are my suggestion; however, I would be most grateful if you would look at these suggestions very critically in case you can suggest better alternatives.

Since I have not officially cleared this programme with Mr. Redpath, I would be very pleased to have your estimate of the cost of carrying out this programme.

I look forward to having your comments on these proposals.
