Notes on Gold Property Offered Perkins Peak Area, British Columbia \_\_\_\_\_\_92-N-14

On May 27, 1968, Mr. Mike Hretchka (1955 Greelman, Vancouver 9, B.C., telephone number RE-1914), phoned the office this morning to ask if we were interested in examining a gold prospect on Perkins Peak approximately 12 miles south of Kleena-Kleene. I gathered that this was the group of claims formerly known as the "Mountain Boss" and "Mountain Chief". In his telephone call Mr. Hretchka stated that the gold occurrence occured at approximately 7,000 feet a.s.l. and he reported assays of .41 ozs. gold over 51.5 feet in arsenopyrite minerals with quartz veins.

The available literature on these showings which have been known for many years indicate that gold values are comparatively low. In one of the attached photocopies there is a suggestion that one of the better representative samples runs .24 oz. gold over six feet. In a general way the available literature on these showings would indicate that their gold tenure is low, they are fairly remote, have had a fair amount of work done on them and generally speaking, don't sound too intriguing for such a remote area. I propose to phone Mr. Hretchka on May 31, 1968, and advise him that we do not wish to make an examination of this property.

A brief note on the geology is as follows:

The gold-bearing veins occur in a series of sedimentary rocks including argillites, sandstone and conglomerates which are overlain by thick beds of volcanic breccia. The mineralization is in large quartz veins or silicified zones, which, although quite large, are said to contain small amounts of gold (G.S.C. Summary Report 1925A, Page 162).

Just as a matter of interest, Mr. Hretchka, a Campbell shareholder, is a Hotel owner at Port Moody.
