POWER RIVER CLAIMS, VANCOUVER ISLAND

Jim McDonald of Vancouver owns 100 mineral claim units on Power River 10 miles south of Port Alice on the northwest coast of Vancouver Island.

The claims cover magnetite deposits worked by Riocanex in the early 1960's. Available data indicate three magnetite lenses to be small and linear, generally not exceeding 500 ft. in the long direction. These are related to faulting in Karmutsen volcanics and depth potential appears to be limited. Very little skarn alteration has been noted.

Riocanex drilled several holes and the core is reportedly stored near the old camp. McDonald proposes re-sampling of the core to check for gold values at an estimated cost of \$5000. Helicopter access is necessary.

This propapect is considered to be of marginal interest only.
