1971 - formation of Luc Syndicate

- to search for a large Cu or Cu-moly deposit

Location - Omineca Mts from  $50^{\circ}30'N$  to  
 $56^{\circ}15'N$  and  $125^{\circ}$  to  $126^{\circ}15'W$ .

Burn group - specific project NTS 93/N-36,11  
lat.  $55^{\circ}30'N$   
long.  $125^{\circ}15'W$ .

Amax discovers Lennac Lake Cu property

1972 - main Luc program in the Babine Lake area

- continued work in the Omineca River area

- BURN project cont.

1973 - work in the Babine Lake area -  $55^{\circ}05'N$ ;  $126^{\circ}25'W$

Omineca

- Fort Claim group - po, py + chpy in peak of  
Old Fort Mtn.

- some work also undertaken in the area north  
of Takla Lake.

- Burn project - Follow-up program proposed including drilling, Comwest declined to participate
  - Lennac Lake program - NTS: 93-2-9, 16  
 $54^{\circ}45'N$ ;  $126^{\circ}19'W$   
→ joint venture between Amax Potash Ltd., The LVC Syndicate, and Standard Oil Company of B.C.
  - Cu mineralization.
- Takla Lake area - Lion I & II claim groups & NTS: 93-11-16 E  
 $55^{\circ}54'N$ ;  $126^{\circ}05'W$ 
  - Cu mineralization in volcanics
- Hol group - Babine Lake Area
  - property on the Fulton River in the Babine Lake area NTS: 93-11-2  
 $55^{\circ}04'N$ ;  $126^{\circ}45'W$ .
  - possible disseminated Cu-moly occurrences of the porphyry type.

1974 - IP survey on the Burn claims

- Lennac Lake Drill program → 44 percussion drill holes in 1973 & 5 diamond drill holes in 1974.
  - Done -

1975 - Dome carried out exploration program on the Burn Group in 1975

- work on Burn #1 Group - Kwanika Creek area NTS 93-N-6, 11

- previous work on Burn Group ie moly + Cu geochem surveys, mag surveys, I.P., trenching + 12 diamond drill holes did not reveal significant mineralization ie source of moly anomaly.

- in 1975 geology mapped + float examined, several more drill holes recommended.

1976 - more drilling on Burn Group - nothing of sign. revealed.

1977 - Col claims dropped.

1976 - Drilling on Burn Group revealed nothing of significance.

- no further work was recommended.

1977 - Col claims dropped.

1979/80 - Burn group farmed out to Place Development - they did a re-evaluation of the property, but could not find source account for moly anomaly.

1980 - Burn group given back to Dome,
