Dear Sir:

Our Company owns a very attractive silver property 5 Km southeast of Stewart, B.C. which we have been assessing the past three seasons. The claims cover five sub parallel shear-vein systems which produced direct-shipping ore in 1929-1931 under Premier Mines ownership. Exploration had been non-existent prior to our recent re-evaluation.

With a combined program of rehabilitation and percussion drilling we have identified probable reserves of 600,000 tons of 20 oz/ton silver in 2 shoots on 2 separate veins. We have not yet gained access to the bulk of the old workings for further exploration. Surface prospecting has discovered new exposures which indicate a vertical range on the veins of 1,300 feet and a known strike length of at least 2,500 feet. They vary in width from 3 to 40 feet.

We have reached a point in our exploration expenditures where the participation of a senior integrated mining company would be beneficial to the property. If you wish to review the entire data package please contact the writer.
