We are seeking a joint venture partner or optionee on this property.

Geophysical/geochemical surveys and geological mapping have been completed with positive results. Numerous gold bearing veins have been mapped.

At present our interest centres on one sulphide vein strike which extends continuously for 2100 feet, in 2 directions, and grades about 1/2 ounce gold per ton. This past summer we did some preliminary mining on this vein, the ore being shipped to Cominco Ltd. at Trail, B.C. for processing. Results of this bulk sampling are very encouraging.

We wish to get right to the meat of this situation by initiating some development mining, which we feel would be profitable and could help to offset further exploration costs. An initial expenditure of approximately \$350,000 should be adequate to get things rolling.
