Very important cut we made, exposing mineralized ore, few hundred feet N.E. of wide vein area. Piece of shale is massive pyrites.



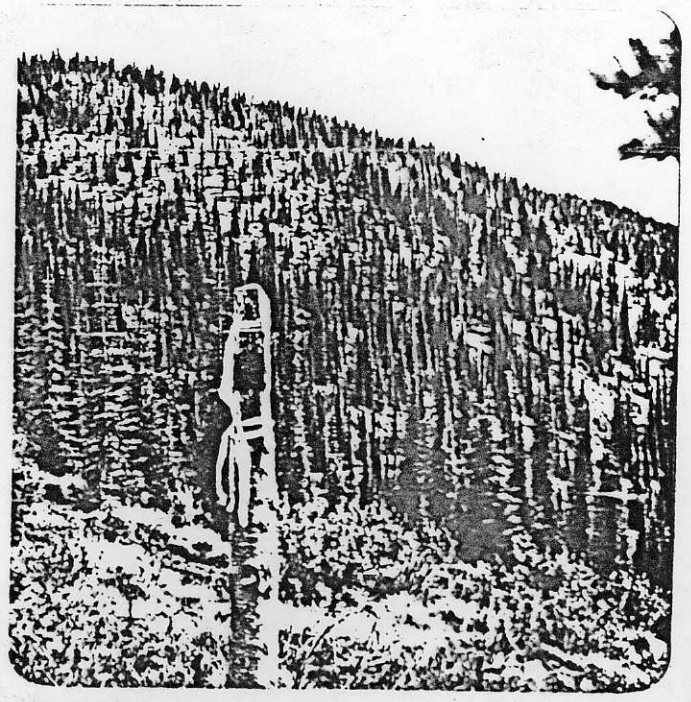

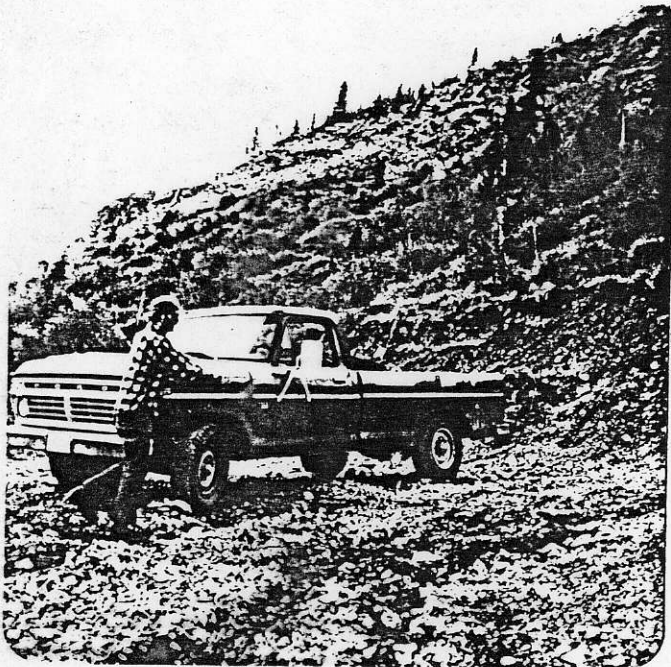

"OGG" "location Tag #1" one inch to left of top of post can be seen faint trace of trail heading toward "Sun" mine.



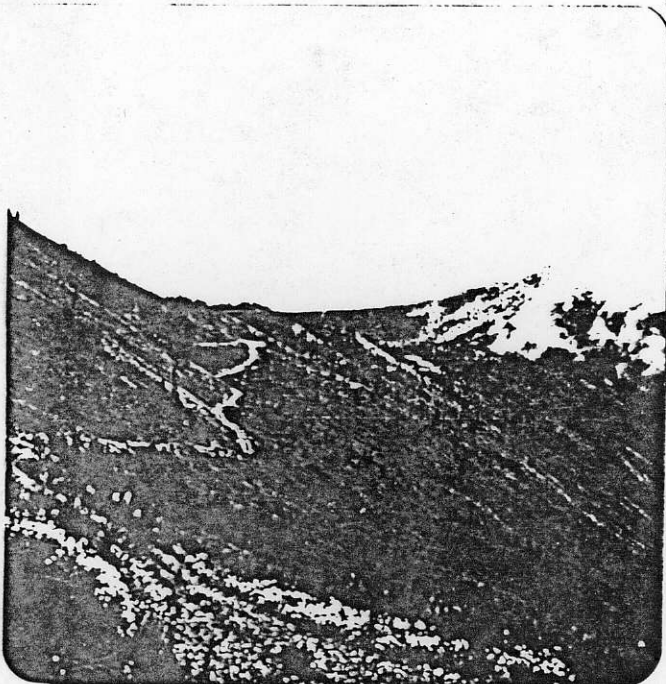
Jeep trail 1000' from Forestry
