HIGHLIGHTS:

Aumax (Gary Polischuk, PAP grantee) - discussed with Derek Brown (GSB) the idea of a small GSB mapping project for this interesting new high grade silver-gold prospect near Lillooet. Gerry Ray may be able to do this project, with the goal of writing a short Fieldwork article for publication at Round-up. Polischuk submitted a notice of work this week for 21 excavator trenchs/pits. Grab samples of quartz-tetrahedrite vein material have returned up to 80 oz/ton Ag and 0.14 oz/ton Au.

Ample Goldmax (Gold-Ore Resources Ltd.) - results released for a 9 hole/907 m drilling program located a few km SW of Lillooet. Six of the nine holes interesected anomalous gold values with the best hits being 3.69 m of 5.46 g/t Au and 1.5 m of 9.53 g/t Au. The results of all drilling to date (including Homestake from 1996-7) indicate there is a moderate to high grade (7-31.5 g/t Au), northeast plunging shoot 50 to 100 m wide, 1.5 to 8 m thick and at least 200 m long. (NOTE: This is another Polischuk discovery and was supported by a PAP grant to partner Dave Javorsky in 1995).

Warner Gruenwald (PAP grantee) - field visit tomorrow to review the results of his work in the Antsey range north of Malakwa.

Golds Hike Bizar (Cassidy Gold Corp) - a new float occurrence has been identified on this intrusion-related gold property located near Blue River. Crenulated biotite schist with disseminated pyrrhotite and chalcopyrite returned assays up to 1.7 g/t Au, 466 ppm As, 79 ppm Bi and 361 ppm Cu. Cassidy is preparing to show the property to major companies for joint venture.

HIGHLIGHTS:

Ample-Goldmax (Gold Ore Resources) - Field visit on 6/09 with Wayne Pickett, geologist for Gold-Ore. This property is located in very steep terrain between Cayoosh Cr and Seton L., a few km west of Lillooet. Previous drilling by Homestake (26 holes, 1996-7) encountered mesothermal quartz-carbonate veins with visible gold and minor arsenopyrite-pyrite at the thrust-faulted contact between Cayoosh Assemblage phyllitic sediments (below) and greenstones of the Bridge River Group (above). Homestake's best hole, # 16, hit 11.76 g/t Au over 8.2 m. Gold Ore has drilled 6 of 9 planned holes, mainly at a 50 m drill spacing in the vicinity of Hole 16. Visible gold is evident in several of the new holes (Confidential). Results should be released in late June. Approximately \$80K will be spent this year. Significantly, this project can be at least in part attributed to a 1995-6 PAP grant of \$8600 to co-owner Dave Javorsky (the other 50% is owned by Gary Polischuk). Spending by Homestake and Gold Ore since Javorsky/Polischuk first optioned it to Homestake (fall '95) totals \$1.05 million - excellent leverage from the PAP seed money!

Downton Creek area (Gary Polischuk - 1999 PAP grantee) - Field visit (6/09) to view several of Gary's targets in the Downton Creek-Cayoosh Creek area approx 10 km west of Ample-Goldmax property. He is a diligent, hard working and observant fellow and has several excellent projects to work this year. There are two main targets, gold-silver bearing mesothermal quartz veins in the Bridge River Group/Cayoosh Assemblage and beautiful **rhodonite**-quartz bodies (decorative stone) which appear to occur in shear zones within the Bridge River Group. Solid blocks of rhodonite-bearing material up to 30 cm square were viewed at Gary's home. Gary has staked the Aumax group between Cayoosh and Phair Creek to cover the former target, and the Southern Gem #1-2 to cover the rhodonite. (Confidential).

Christopher James Gold Corp - New president is Mark Tompkins, a mining engineer formerly with Teck and several other companies. News release reviewed their three main properties in our region, Big Kidd (Au-Cu), PGR (Au-Ag-Cu....) and Brassie (Cu-Zn-Au...). Rumour is they plan to finance shortly and finally drill the Big Kidd.

Dick Kaolinite (Gordon Webster) - finally tracked down the ownership of a mysterious sample (a long story) of fairly good quality kaolinite. This material occurs on the Dick claim of Gordon Webster, which is located near Whipsaw Cr (Princeton area). This is a significant commodity and property which I will follow-up this summer. Discussed with Jack Marr, Agate Bay Resources who have \$\$\$ and are looking to perhaps get into the industrial minerals business.

Upcoming - plan to visit PAP grantees Camille Berube (6/12) and Denis Delisle (6/16) to view new prospects, and S. Paradis (GSC) who is starting a mapping project near Samatosum mine. *Wike*
