

On September 12th Nick Carter, Wayne Livingstone and myself toured the Alice Arm area. Dave Newman picked us up at Cedarvale (coffee shop) and we flew directly over the mountains to Nass Camp and then down the power line past Bell Moly and into Kitsault. We saw where Climax had done this year's drilling at Bell Moly as well as the 2 holes on the SW part of B.C. Moly across the creek in the woods. (Apparently no good). We flew down the inlet by Roundy Creek, Tidewater and then back to Alice Arm. We talked with Dwight Collison and took him with us up to the head of the Kitsault valley where he has a number of showings north of (called *Lucky Strike*) Combination Mountain. We flew over the old Homestake cabin and showings and also the old Vanguard cabin and adit. Dwight's showings are a number of veins with PbS and ZnS and cpy and py in qtz. veins and shears and 1st in volcs. (same general trend). It would be interesting to map the area in detail.

We then flew back to Alice Arm and looked at the drill core that Dwight obtained from last year's drilling (3 short holes). We marked off lengths for assay for him and will have the Dept. do the assaying.

We (Nick and I) returned to Alice Arm on Sept. 17th to look at Bell Moly and pick up Dwight's drill core. Climax used the chopper for a drill move-out.

We noted 'young' lava beds near the head of HOAN Creek on the way in.
