- office visit to Chris Graf
- excellent structural report by Peter Lewis (incl. structural isophtests)
- major NW-trending fault separates Cardiac "target" from new (1996) discovery (in draw north, transverse from Core Shack ridge).
- '97 to test for oblique strike + structurally off set min!
- still like idea of u/c access
- Ecstall budget \$1.2M for '97, contingent on financing
- [Noranda (Ron McArthur) looking at very carefully]

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July 19/99

- chat with Chris Graf (Ecstall)
- Inmet has 'fulfilled' its expenditures obligations to earn up to 60% (Ecstall has 40%)
- by spending \$, Ecstall can increase its ownership to 51% (?).
- Chris likes Peter Lewis' 1997 'structural' rpt. eg. more targets 'along' Cardiac Ck. 'horizon' (esp. to east). - Eg. should drill downslope, below horizon.
- good geochem (eg Zn) + geophys. anomalies along strike to NW — untested

- chat with Chris Graf - 'update'
[Inmet holds 60% of Estall - 40%]
- In 1999, Estall had planned a \$500k delh program - primarily to test the "South Zinc" anomaly (SSE, across creek) of Cardiac zone plus perhaps follow up (deep) Bear Valley zone zone (\pm 2 km N of Cardiac zone horizon)
- possible fault (structural) complications
- in N-S Zn-Pb soil anomalies from Elk to Huen ['Southern Gateway']
- * - strat. (min.) plunge to SE?
i.e. run out of (less) limestone in section?
