ABSTRACT

Harrison Lake Gold Project, Bear Mountain, B.C.

The paper reports progress being made by Kerr Addison Mines Limited, Bema International Resources and ABO Resource Corp. in exploring a potential medium size, low grade gold deposits amenable to high production underground mining, 100 kms east of Vancouver, B.C. The project area lies within the western flank of the Cascade Mountain System. Tertiary granitic stocks intrude Jurassic sedimentary rocks and host the deposits. Mineralization consists of a quartz vein stockwork containing visible native gold, pyrrhotite, minor pyrite, chalcopyrite and a rare gold-silver-bismuth telluride. Some 643 tonnes of selected ore averaging 48 grams/tonne (1.4 ozs/ton) were mined from a 30 cm. wide quartz vein in the period 1972-82. The grade of the bulk mineable zone is in the order of 3 to 3.5 grams/tonne (0.10 ozs/ton).
