SUMMARY OF BELL MINE EMERGENCY PLAN

WHAT IS A MAJOR EMERGENCY?

Any situation such as a serious uncontrolled fire or explosion that could cause injury to plant personnel or visitors and/or severe damage to equipment and property.

HOW AM I WARNED THAT A MAJOR EMERGENCY EXISTS?

You will be warned by the major emergency alarm.

Unless otherwise advised, visitors are to follow the routes shown on the drawing to the safe area.

SAFE AREA...

The safe area is the lower Admin. #1 or, if Admin. is unsafe, Mill Maint. (#2) shown on the drawing overleaf.

Once in the safe area, immediately report to the person you were visiting. He will report your presence to the emergency co-ordinator. Remain in the safe area until otherwise instructed.

NOTE

If you do not understand the above, please check with the receptionist before entering the minesite.

PLEASE RETURN CARD TO RECEPTIONIST
