We have had a good summer working the Big Nic Project and have found some more mineralization at what we call the SPX showing. This mineralization is layered in places; fine grained; net-textured and has all the features of fractional crystallization and in-situ formation. The massive sulphide mineralization or the Big Nic that we originally found several years ago is coarse grained with orthopyroxene inclusions. It appears that this style of mineralization was injected from a parent intrusion into hypersthene diorite (Spuzzum) host rocks.

As I mentioned, the variety of textures and other features that we have encountered are text-book for mafic mingling and mixing. Other features are just not in any literature that I have searched (and that has been voluminous). I have attached a few pictures that may be of interest.
