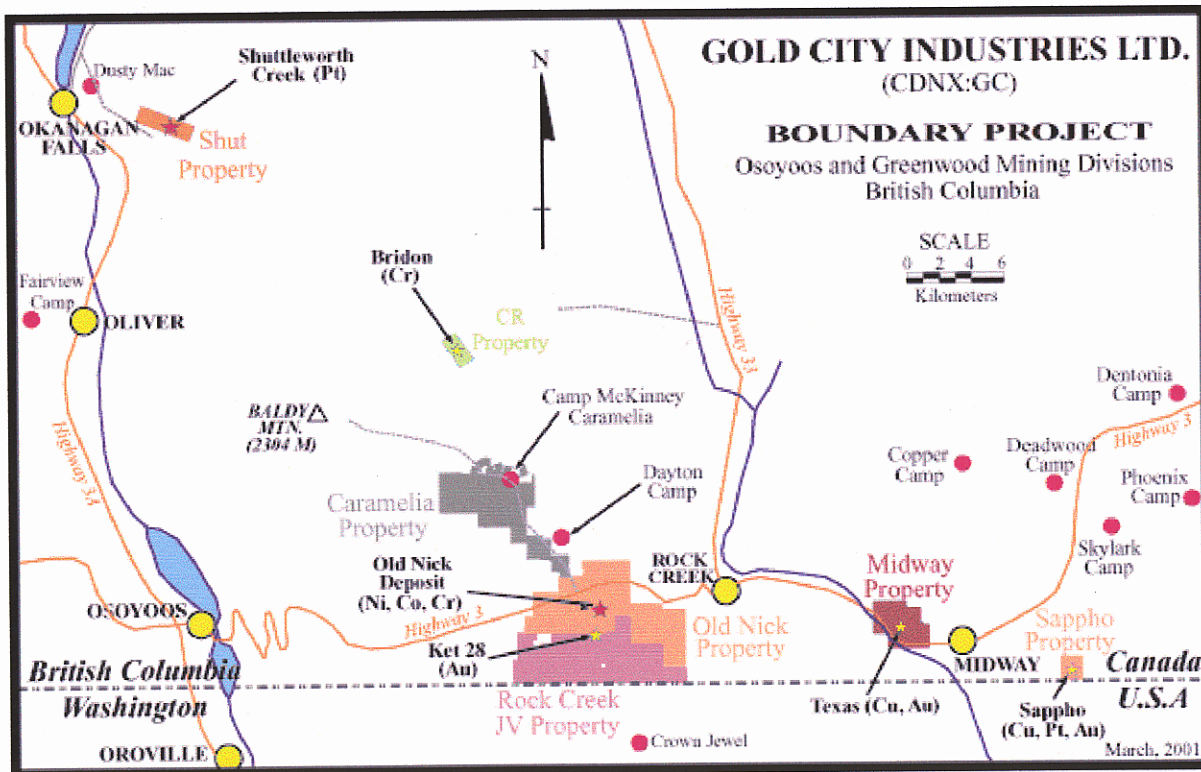

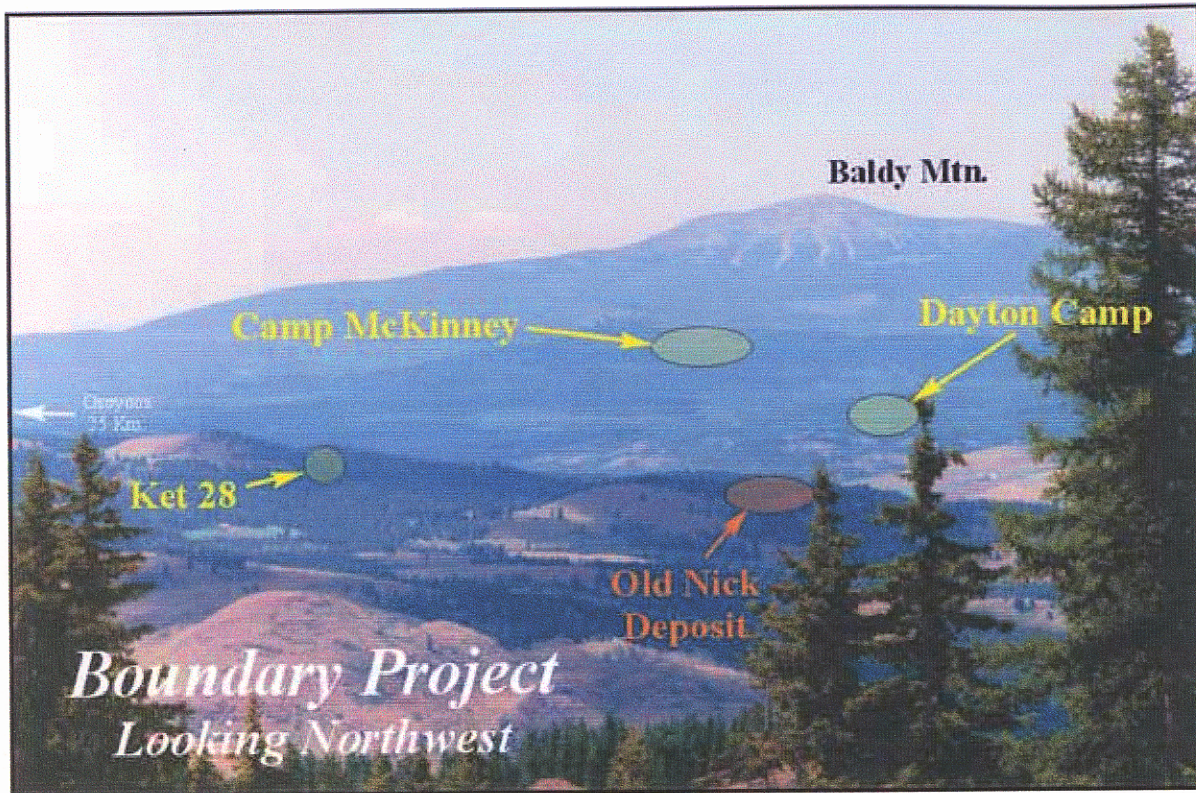


**BOUNDARY PROJECT**

The Boundary Project, totalling 9,875 hectares, is centred around Rock Creek, BC approximately 30 kilometres east of Osoyoos. The Boundary Project lands include the Company's 100% owned Caramelia Property (~ 2,000 hectares) and Old Nick Property (~3,100 hectares), and a 44% interest in the Rock Creek Gold Trend Joint Venture (~3,200 hectares). In addition, since the beginning of the 2001, the Company has purchased 100% interest in the Shut (350 hectares), CR (200 hectares), and Midway (800 hectares) properties, has optioned the Sappho (225 hectares) property, and has staked additional ground contiguous with its Old Nick Property.

The area surrounding the Company's Boundary Project lands has seen considerable mining activity since 1859, when BC's earliest gold rush began at Rock Creek. The Rock Creek area lies within the Cordilleran intrusive belt, defined by Permo-Triassic Anarchist Group sediments and volcanics. Numerous altered ultramafic and serpentinite bodies and dykes are found in the Anarchist Group at Rock Creek. Ultramafic rocks host the majority of platinum group deposits worldwide. The potential of this area is supported by anomalous concentrations of platinum group pathfinder elements including copper and chromium. Further, historic records indicate platinum was recovered from placer operations on Rock Creek at the turn of the century.

Due to increases in the prices of platinum and palladium, the Company will focus most of its 2001 exploration activities on its Boundary Project near Rock Creek in southern BC. The Company will review the geological model for platinum group elements (PGE's) for the Rock Creek area. Available drill core from past drill programs will be assayed for PGE's. Prospecting, mapping, sampling, and trenching programs to identify drill targets will be carried out.
