Dorthe: re- your fax dated Mar. 13/96. I offer the following:

- 1) See EXPLORE B.C. (M-27) for most recent details (I haven't seen FINAL report)
- 2) The Bonanza zone is the 'main', high-grade zone of mineralization found within the Main Shear zone. It's the only zone on the property with a reserve/resource figure - as quoted in my '95 Overview. By the end of 1995, approx. 225 tonnes of mineralization with an anticipated/expect grade of 34.18 g/t Au and 63.43 g/t Ag were stockpiled from a surface mining program on the R.W. vein. The R.W. vein is located approx. 15m west of the Main Shear zone; and may be the northwest continuation/offset of the 'main' vein which hosts the Bonanza zone, or simply an offshoot. More exploration work is required to further define the association.
- 3) I plan a site visit sometime this summer (last visit = July '94).
I hope this helps. Tom
