Manalta Coal-Telkwa Project provided an update to the EAO and to members of the project committee. Modifications within the context of the Project Specifications are being made to the proposal. The EAO identified to the Manalta items which may become <u>major</u> areas of concern in the future. Company aware of them and ensuring adequate response in Project Report. Manalta anticipates submitting Project Report in <u>next 2</u> to 3 months.

The EAO called a meeting with the <u>Bronson Slope</u> proponents (International Skyline Gold) to determine the status of their response to the <u>Project Specifications</u>. LAND USE PLANNING
