- * Dillion Mine of Western Canadian Coal started mining in December.
- * Mine is located 50 kilometers south by road of Chetwynd.
- * Dillon was the second new mine in BC in 2004 (Willow Creek other and Gibraltar re-opened in October).
- * Dillon Mine loaded sixth unit train January 5, 2004.
- * The mine has produced more than 60,000 tonnes of coal since it opened (by Jan. 5 2004).
- * Mine employs approximately 100 workers and contractors.
- * Coal is used in manufacture of steel.

- * On January 12? Western Canadian Coal plans to ship
 Xxx tonnes of coal in a Panamax? ship from Prince Rupert?

- * This is the first BC coal shipped through Ridley Terminal from the new generation of mines in the Peace River coalfields.
- * another point or two from WCC - perhaps get their news release
- * Continued shipments of coal will mean more jobs for Prince Rupert and rail workers.
