*B. Madu and I spent a day touring Henry Awmack and Mark Baknes of Equity Engineering to unstaked VMS prospects and till anomalies in the Eagle Bay Assemblage. Bob Friesen of Teck also came along and showed us the geology and untested potential at Samatosum Mine. Our goal is to attract a serious group to take a fresh look at the district. I think everyone was impressed with the exploration database and the available prospective ground.

CAM *Tombstone-style vein or stockwork gold prospect discovered in Baldy Batholith? Cam Claims (Honeymoon Bay, Adams Lake). Prospector Camille Berube has had property visits by Teck and Cyprus in the last few weeks. Following up on the best gold anomaly (215 ppb) from last year's Eagle Bay till release, Camille discovered a quartz vein up to 12 m wide and at least 200 m long which assays up to 26.66 g/t Au. Despite being on a logging road, this appears to be a new discovery with no previous work. Fluorite veins and pyroxene-garnet-pyrrhotite skarn also occurs in the area. Given that Au is associated with Bi, Pb, As, Sb, Cu and Mo and is hosted by Cretaceous monzonite (approx 100 ma), this new prospect has broad similarities with Tombstone Suite deposits, particularly Stoneboy (Pogo) in Alaska. Outliers and margins of Baldy-Raft suite intrusions may be a good place to look for other bulk tonnage, intrusion-hosted Au deposits. There are other Au +/- Bi, Pb, As, Cu anomalies in RGS and till surveys in this area which deserve to be prospected.
