- 5 ddh from 2 set-ups (3/2), plus a 6th one ~ 200 m along strike tested massive sulphide (horizon) min. between 'basaltic' sills within argillites — near nose of fold. — zone dips into hill @ ~ 45°
- no economic assays, but good area/model!
- Brittan Bros. did drilling; pad const. by Blaine Deiter (son of Ralph)
- Both Doublestar (Sustut) + Northgate (Kemess) ended up 'canceling' chopper commitment with ~~the~~ West, Luck, in favour of Okanagan Heli (GL 'pissed off!')

HW & FW = sediments and sills (i.e. little volc.)

- strat. dips ~ 45° into hillside
