

## Skeena Mining Division

- Cimadaro*
- Cimadaro: At the Cimadaro prospect on Moresby Island, optioned from Doromin Resources, Teck Exploration drilled six holes totalling approximately 1000 metres and have left the property for the season. According to Andy Betmanis, project geologist for Teck, there are only two showings. The upper showing is a lens of massive pyrite containing low gold values and some barite. The more interesting lower showing consists of a lens of polymetallic m.s. about 6m x 2m and contains minor Au and Ag. It appears to be stratabound within a package of thin-bedded chert and argillite immediately beneath the Karmutsen formation (Sicker group or Ladinian sediment sill?). Contrary to early press releases issued by Doromin, Teck indicates that the drill holes encountered only disseminated pyrite and pyrite stringers with no massive sulphides. Furthermore, there were no significant assay results. The property remains an intriguing geological situation, but the early exploration results have been quite devastating considering the amount of hype generated by the property owners.

B) ACTIVITIES

- Annual Exploration Review: Most available time in early November was devoted to accumulation and organization of exploration activity data and to preparation of slides for talk to staff on exploration highlights in the district (November 8th).
- November 8th: All day staff meeting including brief presentations by the district geologists on exploration highlights in their districts.
- Some time was spent later in November organizing detailed data on highlight properties for inclusion in Vic's presentation at Spokane.
- Parts of several days in early December were devoted to further acquisition of data and revision of table for annual exploration report.
- A first draft of the text, table and map for the annual exploration report was completed by December 21st, requiring only minor updating to be done in the first week of January.
- Preliminary Map 65: A revised version of the "Producers Map" was compiled and submitted on November 29th with a minor change on December 1st (addition of first mineral inventory for Debbie project).
- CGC Committee: Compilation of a detailed listing of client contacts and various other deliberations and discussions culminated in a one hour meeting on November 9th with the Canadian Geoscience Council Committee to discuss the future role and priorities of district offices - hat's off to Dave Lefebvre for an excellent job in taking the lead on this activity.
