Yes, it's called "Sheslay" or "Copper Creek" [MI104J 035]. I'm told that significantly increased staking to the west now includes the Phyrrotite Creek property. The last 'serious' exploration on the property was done in 1991 when one of Murray Pezim's companies, Golden Ring Resources. The target was bulk tonnage Cu-Au and polymetallic massive sulphide deposits. The work was focused on the Copper Creek, Upper Dick Creek and Dick Creek areas. Six diamond drill holes were completed in 1970 on the Copper Creek area, the best intercept averaging .485%Cu over 44m. Unfortunately, with the change in government policies and globalization of the mining industry in 1992, most exploration in BC 'moved on' to other areas. At the time, the Golden Bear mine road was considered a very important factor for doing exploration in this very remote area. I late 2002, three propsectors/geologists (Adam Travis, Don Barker and Dave Mehner) could see the exploration business about to turn around and had enough confidence in the government that they staked this ground. In February, 2003 they completed an option agreement with Firesteel Resources Inc. The property has developed drill targets that will be drill tested this year, as well as other partially developed targets that require further definition work. The management of Firesteel believes that the property has excellent potential to host an economic alkalic porphyry Cu-Au deposit (i.e. similar to Galore Creek, Red Chris, Copper Creek and Kiniskan). In 2003, Firesteel completed geophysical and geochemical surveys, in preparation for drilling in 2004. I have been assisting David Dupre, President, with their work.
