Hi Tom: here are a few pictures of the comb quartz from holes 06-8 and 06-9. The physical separation of the core is abot 90 m at the depth of sampling. I have many more examples over a separation of about 1km. more or less. Kirkham has published 2 pictures of comb quartz on a NRCan website from the anticlimax property taken in 1988. Search "comb quartz pics" on google. I believe his pics are taken about 450m nw of my hole 06-9 photos. Lots of local fluorite, bismuthinite, wolframite, strong yellow sericite (fluorosericite?) locally strong quartz flooding +/- K-spar and minor but widespread secondary biotite. small scale local "Brain Texture"

with bismuthinite (?). do you get PGM values in this environment? I would'nt expect gold, but the rock looks juicy enough with good veinlet development of quartz, pyrite, sericite on late stage veinlets 1-7mm Regards,....Bill
